 Ambition: To be an airline stewardess.



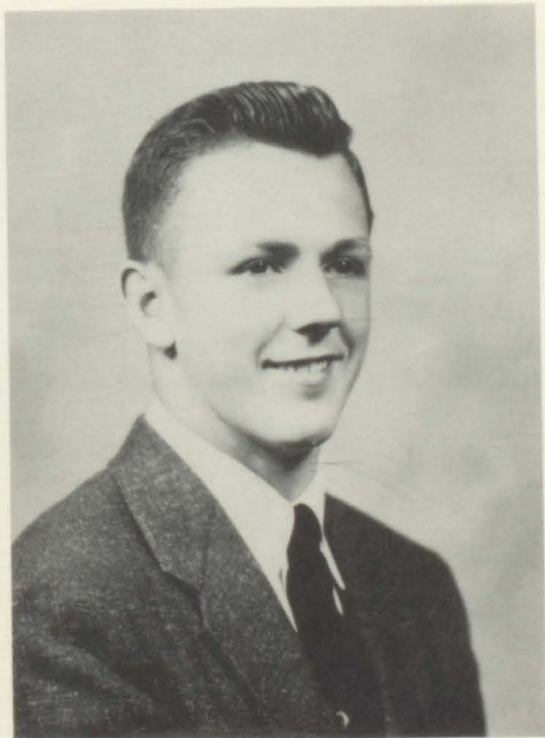
Delores Jean Brown

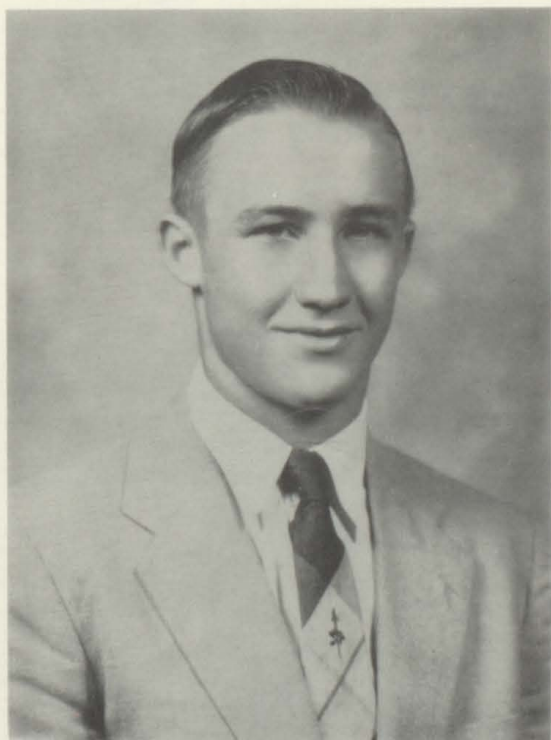
Sharon Lea Haugh

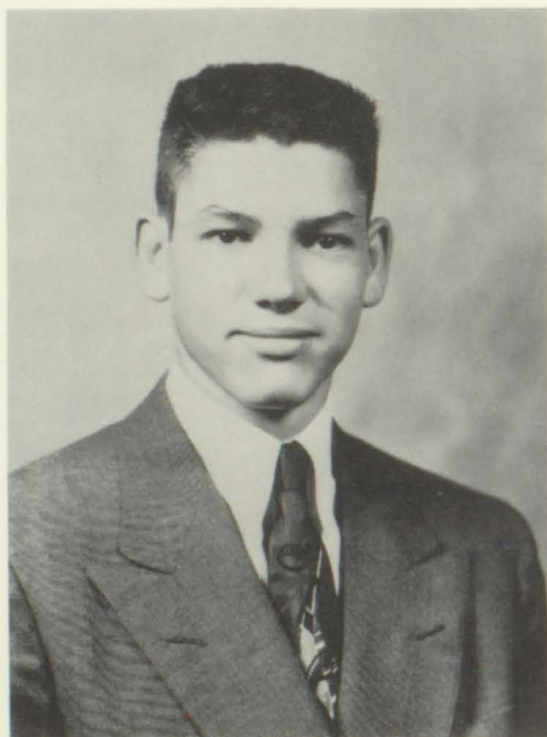


Beverly Ann Lewis

Marilyn Wells wills Carolyn Cochran her ability to yell real loud so Carlisle High School will only need three cheerleaders next year.

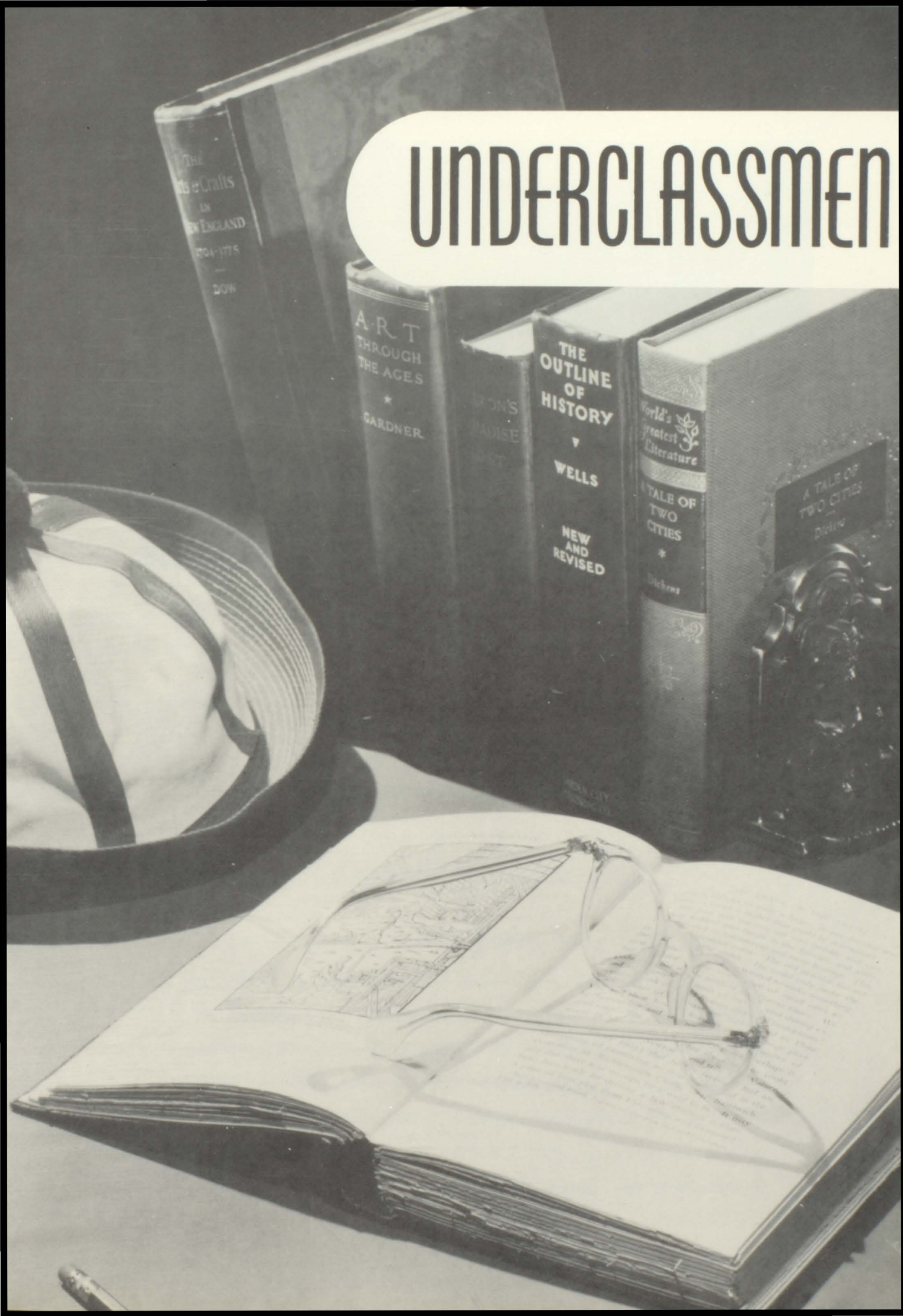
