- 2.Shared Sponsorship of the backpack project for all grades to make sure there aren't children that don't have access to basic school supplies.
- 3. Organized career day activities to allow access to Alumni willing to present their career path with students interested in their occupation.
- 4.Presented adult education in the form of culinary classes using the high school culinary class kitchen.

5.Continued the annual Car Show and "Picker's Day" which was very successful and allows us to raise funds for our programs. The biggest activity of the Alumni Association year is the annual Alumni Banquet. Remember it is the second Saturday of June again, so start planning now to be there. The banquet is good time to get to see classmates and fellow alumni with whom we shared our school days.

Finally, I would like to report on the scholarship program, which is the major financial endeavor for the CAA. The Alumni Association has become the major local source of scholarships for CHS graduates. We, as an organization, were able to participate in CHS Senior Award Night, distributing over 30 scholarships totaling \$83,000. Additionally, each graduate was given a small gift to commemorate their graduation and welcome them into the Carlisle Alumni Association. I should mention we've tailored the scholarships to 2 year, 4 year and Trade School applicants to fit the current trends in post high school education.
